Worbla's® Finest Art (WFA) is ideal for armors & props as well as arts & crafts. This TARDIS made by *Julia M. / Svenja K.* shows how good you can do handicrafts with it.

Pieces of cardboard were used as a base and glued together and then covered with WFA that was heated with approx. 95°C using a heat gun. Small parts were shaped completely by hand without a cardboard core.

A heat gun can easily burn you so it's vital that you follow the manufacturer's guidelines!

Afterwards the TARDIS was painted with acrylics and from the inside a transparent foil was added.

For addings some fancy lights to it a LED was applied on the base of the TARDIS.

Julia M. wrapped her smartphone with aluminum foil and pressed the WFA onto the back. Then she added a holder in the front and in the back some hook-and-loop tape. This Worbla creation allowed her to record hand free videos while playing piano with her smartphone.

Naruvien Art&Design (check FB) created some glamorous protective covers for her smartphone. She wrapped it with plastic and also aluminum foil and covered it with foam rubber, which served later as a base.
