The Make-Up department of the *State Theatre Mainz* uses our **Worbla's® Finest Art** always gladly to create giant heads. These giant heads were sculpted out of clay. Activated with a heat gun, the **WFA** was molded onto these clay heads. Afterwards, using a sculpting tool the imperfections were smoothed out. (For best results, use always metal tools) The finished heads were separated from the mold - in order to see through and for the respiration some holes were made. In conclusion, to make it really fancy, some hair was added and a nice paint job was done. Although the heads are really big, they are still very lightweight and so these **Worbla's® Finest Art** heads are perfect for the use on stage!
