Isabella Josie, a charming West Sussex based milliner, used **Worbla's® Meshed Art** to create a gorgeous pillbox hat.

Firstly, she covered an upturned wooden bowl in aluminum foil. Then she heated the **WMA** and popped it on top of the bowl and pushed the sides down. In a couple of places there were some irregularities which a wet sponge was able to smooth out. Once the **WMA** was completed cool she removed it from the bowl and trimmed the bottom.

She popped the back onto the mold and re-heated the top. Then she popped the fabric over the top and trimmed the sides.

The final part was attaching an elastic headband and covering the side of the hat in fabric. A fabric covered button plus some curled pheasant feathers were added to give a neat finish!
